Hope's Children's Campus is home to several vital community programs, including the leased spaces for STEP, Inc. Early Head Start and UPMC's Pediatric Rehabilitation Clinic. Additionally, the campus houses Hope's Bi-County WIC (Women, Infants, and Children's) Program and Autism Resource Center, further solidifying its role as a hub for comprehensive family services.
